Counteracting the *Ghostwriting* phenomenon

The editorial board of the scientific journal *Acta Asiatica Varsoviensia* requires authors of submitted articles to include details concerning:

- the article's authors
- the authors' affiliations
- the main author of the article's thesis

This requirement is an expression of scientific honesty and reliability, and all discovered cases of its violation will be disclosed, including notification of appropriate institutions to which the author is affiliated, scientific associations, scientific editors' societies, etc.

The editors also expect authors to provide information about sources of financing the researches carried out to the need of the publication, as well as about the contribution of scientific and research institutions, associations, and other entities.
